## EL ELYON

Meaning: The God Most High

## EL MOSHAAH

Meaning: God Who Saves

God will always save us. Just like He saved the Israelites from their lives of slavery in Egypt.

References: Psalm 68:20, Exodus 18:10, Daniel 3

## ELOHIM

Meaning: All Powerful One, Creator

God is over everything in the world and the heavens. He carries us through every difficulty.

References: Genesis 1: 1-3, Deuteronomy 10:17, Psalm 68

## EL ROI

Meaning: The God Who Sees Me

God is fully aware of every circumstance in our life. He knows our troubles.

## IMMANUEL

Meaning: God With Us "I AM"

Jesus is God in human form. His Deity dwells in bodily form.

Meaning: I AM

God is the Alpha and Omega. He doesn't have beginning or an end.

## JEHOVAH-RAPHA

God has the final cure for our spiritual, physical and emotional health. He can heal us.

## JEHOVAH-SHALOM

Meaning: The Lord Is Peace

God conquers our enemies and gives us peace. Jesus is our Prince of Peace
